Frenchboro Ferry (a cheap way to spend 2 hours onboard a vessel traveling from Bass Harbor (western side of Mount Desert Island) to Frenchboro and return (16-mile roundtrip) along a scenic route. It's cheaper than tour boats but you won't have time to get off and explore the island as it is a quick turnaround. Frenchboro is a fishing community of about 40 full-time residents and 2/3 of the island is protected by the Island Heritage Trust with great hiking trails. The harbor is a quaint fishing village and an opportunity for some great photos off the boat. <u>https://www.maine.gov/mdot/ferry/frenchboro/</u>

Barr Island in Stonington hike is wonderful but plan on arriving at the island long before half tide on an incoming tide or after half tide on out-going tide as the sand bar is covered from half tide to high tide <u>https://www.islandheritagetrust.org/2018/wp-content/uploads/2018/12/deeri-barredisland-m-iht.pdf</u>

• Recommend arriving at the island just after low tide to one hour after low tide to give plenty of time for walking the island and getting back across the sand bar before the tide covers it. (Note: tides change every 6 hours from high to low and reverse. Average tide rise 9 to 11 feet)
